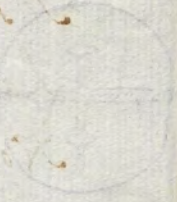
Mitto tibi versus, quos auctor non bene versus

Non ducet vultum si carmen sit mali cultam.

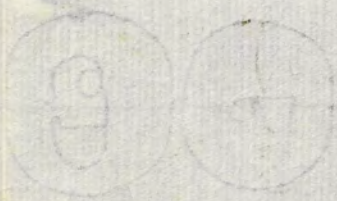
