
Mr. v. Lando. 65 archet ?. Integratie Ent Landb. Cona + bespr. mit. burren. neg.



Both of them have expressed their interest in a closer European co-operation and integration in the agricultural field, but they find that they need more information and examination as to the principles outlined by you, before they will find themselves able to show either a positive or a negative attitude to your plan. Personally I am of the same opinion.

This will be of no surprise to you, I know, because already in your letter of the 7th November 1950 you expressed that you realise you have given a brief exposition on

a problem with so many aspects and with many questions unanswered, and that you will in the first rank rouse our interest in the problem in question.

Even if some supplementary details can be found in the later received document "European Collaboration in Agriculture", and we have had a talk about the matter on the 22nd November last year, as mentioned, I think further information in general and in details will be necessary, before we shall find ourselves able to take up a standpoint to the "Mansholt-plan" and the other plans of integration.

As earlier agreed, a copy of this letter will be handed over to Dr. de Waal the agricultural attaché in Copenhagen to the legation of the Netherlands.
