to bring it after me,

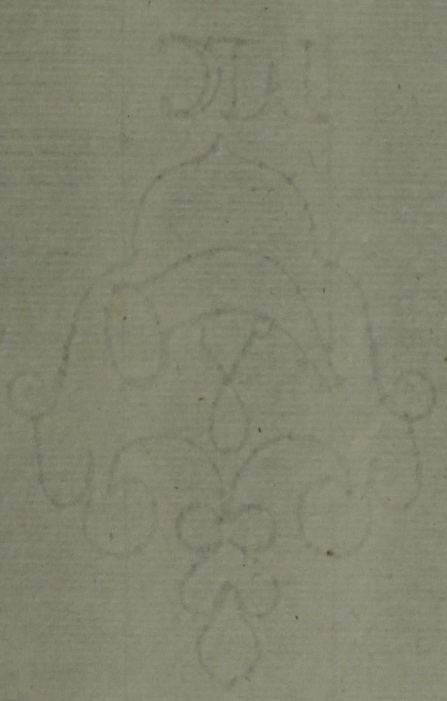
I am confident it will be such
