Festrade either hale or scall wthin few daies receave ord
in it. I find this in hand by this post ready to go away
intending my selfe to follow him to morrow morning there
being a necessity of my attendance of you, about som^r other
particulars as well as this, wherein it shall appere how
constantly the Queene pursues th^r old and chife proposition,
and that th^r very thing concerning the fleet is looked upon
especiallly in ord to that, as the ready meane to bring it to a
present conclusion. I cannot entartaine you now at large
but only this in short, we are now like to proceede in the methode
your first answere wch I carried to Paris last January, did
prescribe, & France intends really & thoroughly to joyne in it.
It is uncertaine yet here, where the Prince fasters, but
by discouer of Hault, and therefore my thoughts are
to come to the Poulder Van Namur. But I can not deter-
mine any thing but this that I am

he part with His Highnes fauour in it, He will not easly be diuerted.
