be waues found to pay for their longer conti-
nuance in the service. W^t perhaps with no dif-
ficult matter to do, it being just & salable
to his owne intigrity, especially if as in all things
you will afford your happy & powerfull assistance
unto this most charitable & necessary works; so
necessary, that it is beleived to be the last occasion
that to morrow waine upon you, for now a minute time myself
will be lost by. My works in your humbld servt S. Goffe.
