Mr Webster hath sent unto the King. 143000^{gs}.
for w^t he hath several parcels of Jewels engaged to him.
Besides the Jewells engaged. There is deposited in his Hands for
His Maties use, a great Ruby Collar and all the Banket bills of
Amsterdam.

But because there is due unto Mr Webster upon account frō the
King about the summe of 40000^{gs}. besides the above said. 143000^{gs}.
for w^t he hath no security. He believeth it unfafe for him to
part with that Ruby Collar till either payment be made of
some part of the whole debt, or other good security be given
him. However it is acknowledged that the Ruby Collar is not
engaged at all to any body. And He offers that It shall be
obliged for security to Calandrinij. either by putting it into
Calandrinij his owne hands, if he wil pay unto him the 40000^{gs}.
or else, By making what act or obligation he will desire that
the Ruby Collar shalbe fairly fully pestrived for Calandrinij in use
till the summe of 100000^{gs}. be paid him according to the condicions
to be made: obliging himselfe to pay the said summe if the Ruby Collar
be otherwise disposed of.

Upon these grounds. The expedient to give Calandrinij
security seeme to be these.

1. To procure some person or bankē to lend 100000^{gs}. or more upon
the said Ruby Collar, and to putt that mony into Mr Websters hand
for His Maties service; who having that mony in his custody will be
ready to give Calandrinij the security. He expidts.
2. If the 100000^{gs}. cannot be plesantly found that some person
who Calandrinij may accept would give him security that in the
month of September next following he would pay unto him the
said summe upon the condicions to be agreed on. And for the
Security

security of that person. His M^t hath transmitted h[er] full powers to engage unto H[im] the Ruby Collar. w^t b^r, because the m^r is not yet required, and most probably never will^r may still remain in Mr Websters hand be giving an obligation, that when it is called for and the money paid it shall be surrendered.

or if this be not accepted, then for Mr Websters satisfaction that party who receives it into his custody may be obliged to priforme for Mr Websters use as well as his own, and the engagement shall be made unto both, for the whole summe of 140000[£].

Besids thi for Mr Websters satisfaction, I shall enable to give him a Ratification fro^r His M^t of all his accounts, according to a forme w^t himselfe hath desired.

Whilst these things are transacting because more time will be spent then the lamentable condicione of His M^t affaires will permitt, It is necessary that Calandrini be immediately dispatched away with assurance that in Septemb^r next if need be he shall find where to receive the 100000[£]. Upon w^t it must be mad^r to promise to proceed clearely & promptly according to such orders as shall be given him.
