Resolution taken at the meeting of the Unity Front of Free West Papua ddo sixth of june 1962.

The Unity Front of Free West Papua consisting of the political parties: EPANG, PONG, PARSEPP and PARNA subdivision Manokwari, after debating the Elsworth Bunker-plan has taken a decision as following:

Contents of the resolution.

Considering:

The Unity Front of Free West Papua cannot agree yet with the Elsworth Bunker-plan, as in this plan is not mentioned clearly at which time (that is date, month and year,) the inalienable right of the people of West Papua (the right of selfdetermination) will come to effect.

Considering more and recollecting:

The Unity Front of free West Papua does not agree yet with a temporary transfer of government in between Indonesian and Dutch rule however temporary: "If the inalien able right of the people of West Papua (the right of selfdetermination) is still a not fully acknowledged stipulation by as well Indonesia as the Netherlands. Recollecting the upbuilding and realisation of economic, social and cultural aspects, which now are quickly developing in favor of the right of selfdetermination of West Papua which is so much needed by its people, all this should not thrown into disorder.

Declares:

The Unity Front of Free West Papua will only be able to agree with a decision whereas in this decision the inalienable rights of the Papuan people are postulated as a fully acknowledged condition from both Indonesia and the Netherlands, witnessed and put in black and white in front of the Acting Secretary-General of the United Nations and allso acknowledged by the parliaments of Indonesia, the Netherlands and West Papua.

Manokwari, june the 12 th 1962

This resolution made out of the nationalist feelings of the four political parties and signed by the chairman and vice-chairman of the Unity Front of Free West Papua.
