''my dear menzies, i should like to let you know through this personal message that the parliamentary debate on n.n.g., on which you will undoubtedly have been informed by ambassador sir edwin mccarthy, has ended with an even larger measure of support for the netherlands government than the cabinet had expected.

the cabinet feels that its position has been strengthened. the dutch press is also showing a more positive attitude. in the international field, the statement of my government was welcomed and appraised. the leading papers abroad consider our position quite reasonable. so does the acting secretary general of the u.n.. only sukarno obstructs the possibility of getting together around the table, and seeking a just solution.

everything will now depend on the forcefulness with which the western powers, especially the u.s. of america and the u.k. will make it clear to sukarno that they will not accept military aggression.

the indonesians should not get away with it when they invade the territory. therefore, you will understand that i was particularly happy with the australian statement on december 30 th.

i can assure you of the cabinet's firm and unanimous resolve not to hand over n.n.g. to indonesia, and of the determination of the military establishment to carry out, when called upon, their duty with confidence and vigour. please accept my warm personal regards. yours very sincerely, joseph luns.''
